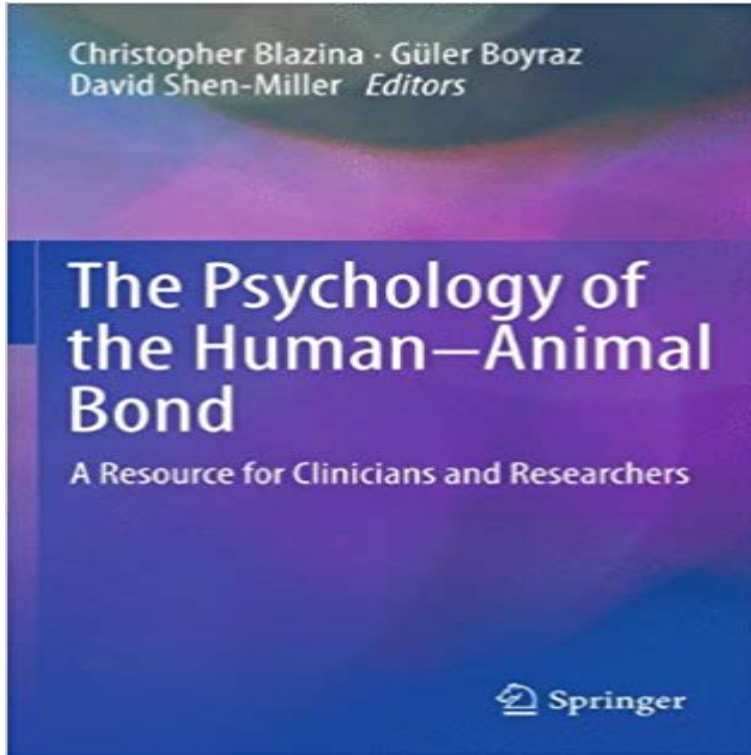


# The Psychology of the Human-Animal Bond: A Resource for Clinicians and Researchers
