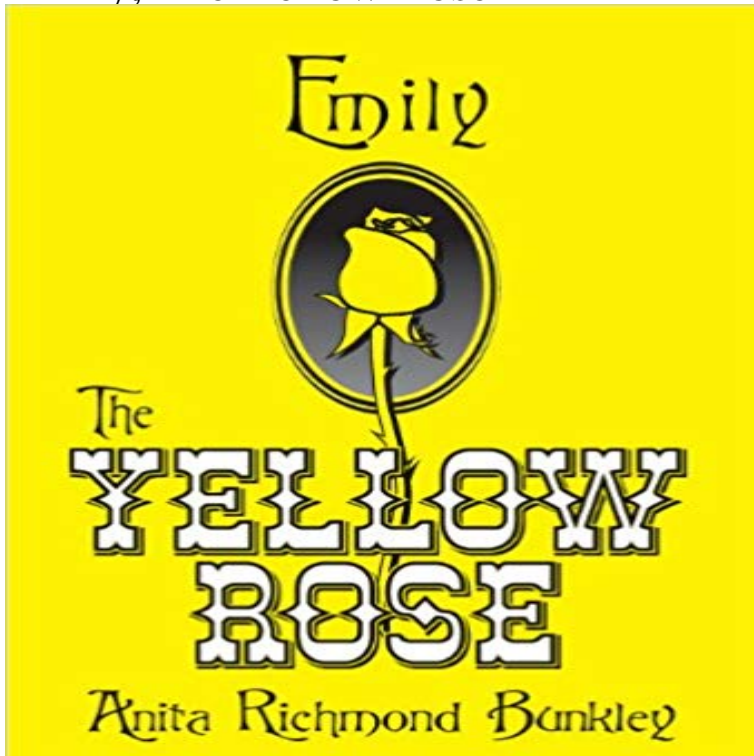


## Emily, The Yellow Rose
