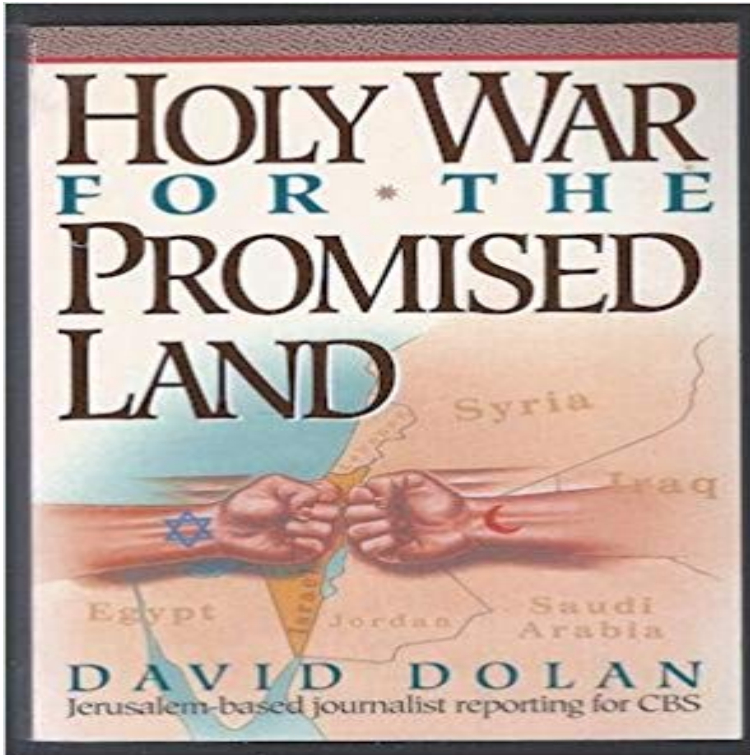


Holy War for the Promised Land: Israels Struggle to Survive in the Muslim Middle East
